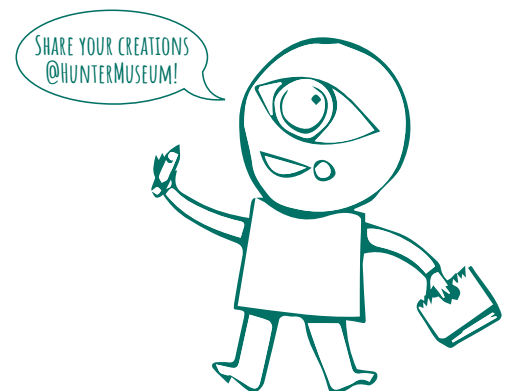
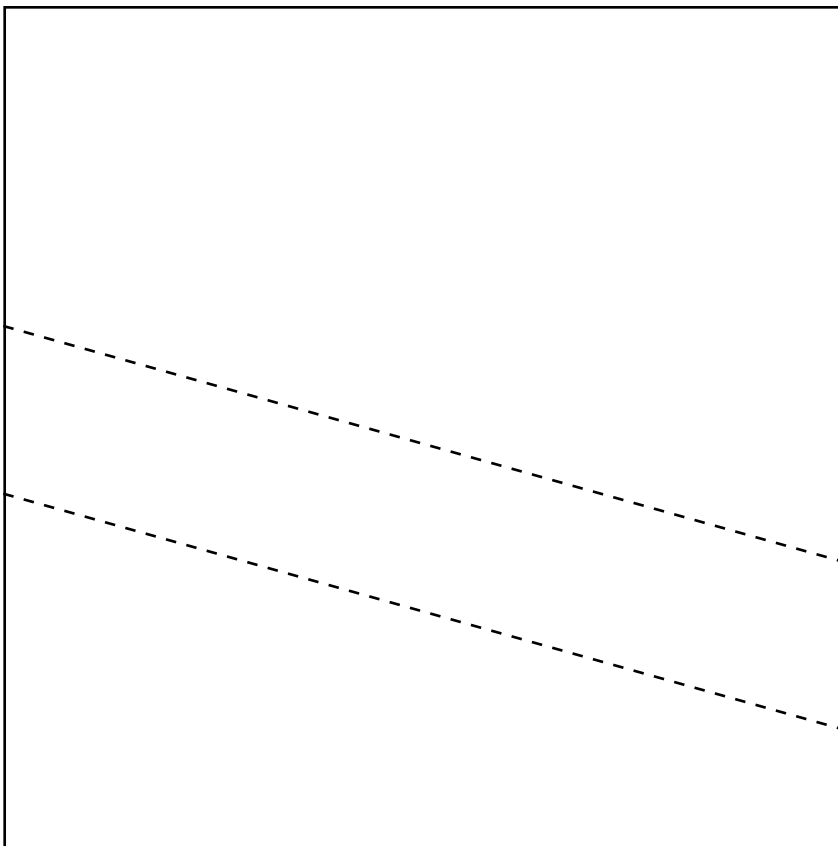
Cool Cubism

Cubist artists like George L.K. Morris loved to make art in a new and unusual way. Instead of drawing objects realistically, cubist artists painted objects as different shapes, all mixed up to make something new. They even included different angles in their artworks, so you could see the top, side, and back of an object all at once.

After looking at George L.K. Morris's painting *Arizona Altar* on the Hunter Museum of American Art's website (emuseum.huntermuseum.org/objects/1584/), create your very own cubist drawing! All you need is something to draw or color with and this worksheet.
