MATERIALS

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Find one or more people to do the activity with you.
2. Take 5 pictures of details around your house or yard. Try to be tricky with your photos by getting close or capturing unusual angles to make the scavenger hunt more challenging.
3. Next, swap your photos with someone else, and try to find the items in each photo.
