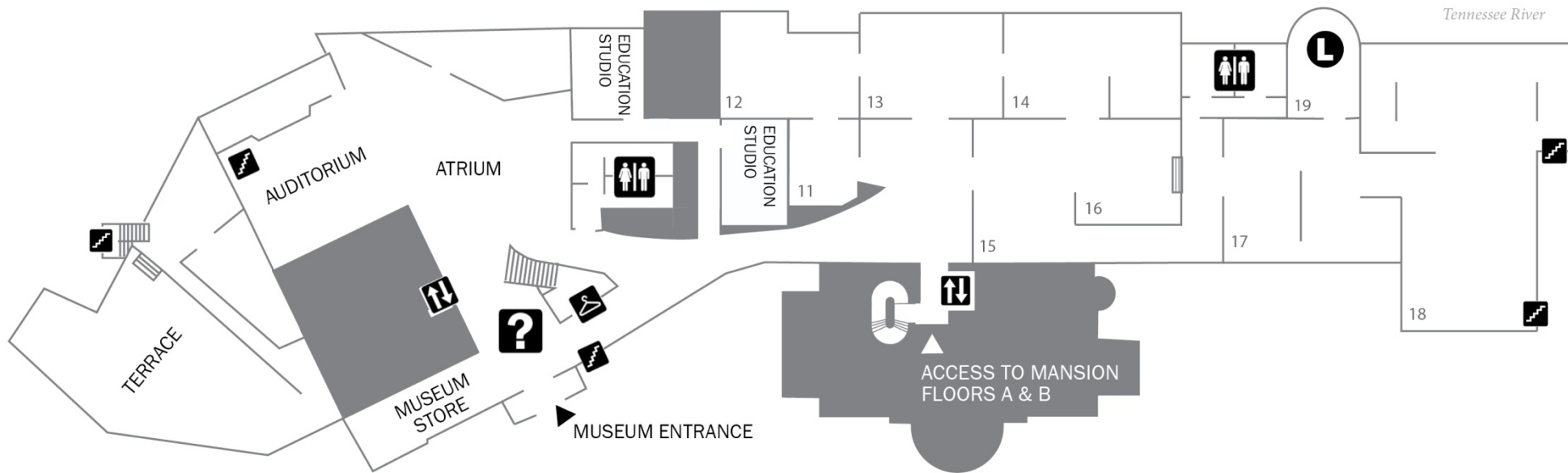

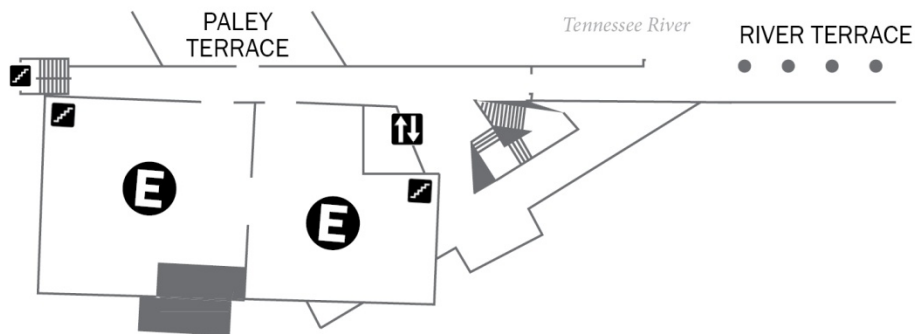

To tour galleries chronologically, please follow gallery numbers in numeric order. Gallery numbers are located in the entrance frame of each gallery.

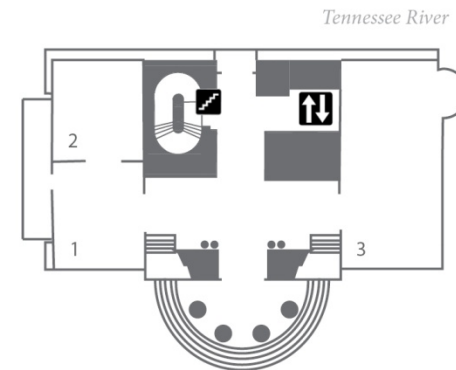
UNIVERSAL ACCESSIBILITY

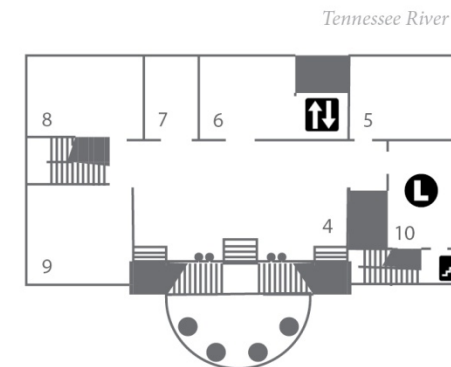
